RAISE A MARGARITA THIS CINCO DE MAYO AT ONE OF LAS VEGAS' BEST MEXICAN RESTAURANTS

For those who can't make it to Mexico, Las Vegas is the next best place to celebrate Cinco de Mayo. Guests can feast upon some tasty South-of-the-Border fare at one of several mouthwatering Mexican restaurants while sipping a refreshing margarita. In fact, the food at these three restaurants is so good that regardless of what day it is, taste buds will be celebrating!

CAÑONITA INSIDE GRAND CANAL SHOPPES AT THE VENETIAN | THE PALAZZO

Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner, guests can dine alongside the Grand Canal Shoppes' picturesque indoor canal while enjoying authentic Mexican offerings like the Huevos Rancheros for breakfast and the Mexico City Enchiladas for lunch or dinner. Other lunch/dinner must-tries include the tasty Flautas made with your choice of chicken or beef and the succulent Carne Asada Norteña served with sweet corn tamales. Whatever you decide on, be sure to try Cañonita's Margarita Flight: three 5-ounce pours of the restaurant's Classic, Jalapeño Infusion and Pineapple Infusion margaritas.

HUSSONG'S CANTINA INSIDE THE SHOPPES AT MANDALAY PLACE

This lively cantina's Ensenada outpost is fabled to be the birthplace of the margarita. Guests can enjoy "the one that started it all" here as well as several other creative concoctions, like the Cotton Candy margarita: an Original Margarita poured over a glass of cotton candy. Coupled with one of the restaurant's delicious dishes, like the flavorful Hussong's Steak rubbed with a three-chile seasoning and topped with chimichurri butter, chile toreado and pickled onions, and guests have a meal to remember—no matter how many margaritas they've had! Just remember to save room for the Dessert Nachos: fried flour tortillas

coated with a cinnamon-sugar mix, drizzled with condensed milk and chocolate sauce and topped with fruit pico de gallo, whipped cream, strawberries and a mint leaf. Yum!

TACOS & TEQUILA AT LUXOR

A restaurant that lives up to its name, T&T (as it's often called) boasts an extensive menu of soft tacos for lunch and dinner, including the scrumptious Barbacoa—oven-roasted lamb shank in Mexican adobo and spices—and the savory Alambre made with grilled steak, bacon, Oaxaca cheese, chile poblano, onion and cilantro. It serves several other Mexican favorites, too, like enchiladas, fajitas and its rich Tortilla Soup. Don't forget to wash everything down with one of the marvelous margaritas, like the White Peach margarita made with Sauza Hornitos Reposado Tequila, fresh lime juice, Peachcello liqueur, agave nectar and fresh peach purée. 🍹
